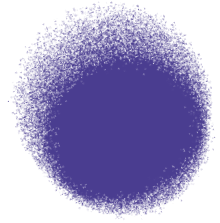


Promotion of Artistic/Scientific Projects

in the areas of gender & queer studies, advanced feminism and/or diversity studies



The Institute for Equality and Gender Studies at the Mozarteum University Salzburg offers grants
up to **500 €**

for students of all fields of study, whose innovative projects/proposals correspond to the understanding of scientific/artistic research/debate in the fields of gender & queer Studies, advanced feminism and /or diversity studies as follows:

- One's own artistic and/or academic practice is understood as research in a defined research context,
 - theoretical and terminological concepts are reflected against the background of structural and historical change,
 - the research questions dealt with are contoured from a critique of normativity and/or recognise intersectional contexts,
- and at the same time
- gender and sexuality are considered explicitly as categories of knowledge (reflection of gender-specific power and domination relations, gender roles, forms of desire, etc.)
- and/or
- construction, deconstruction and reconstruction of aspects of identification (gender, desire, race, class, religion/worldview, age, disability, etc.) in visual, scenic, performative, music-related and/or pedagogical forms/artistic processes are analysed.

Such proposals/projects could include:

- active or passive participation in a topic-specific conference, workshop or course (e.g. Summer School)
- artistic presentations and contributions at the Mozarteum University Salzburg: concerts, scenic presentation/performance, exhibition or installations, etc.
- thematic studies: research in archives or libraries, empirical investigations, etc.

Attention: Publications are a separate funding category, cf. call "Grants Supporting Printing and Publication".

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Current enrolment at the Mozarteum University Salzburg.
- Proposals/projects in connection to a bachelor-, master- or diploma thesis cannot be supported (proposals/projects related to a doctoral thesis – completion of the Rigorosum B obligatory – can be funded in justified cases;).
- A project/proposal can only be funded once.
- Documentary evidence, receipts and a short report of the successful implementation of the proposal/project must be submitted to the Institute for Equality and Gender Studies within one month after the proposal/project has been completed.

APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

- 1) Completed form.
- 2) Curriculum vitae (in tabular form).
- 3) Expose/detailed description of the project/proposal (max. 1500 words), which corresponds to the presented understanding of scientific/artistic research/debate in the fields of gender & queer studies, advanced feminism or diversity studies:
 - problem statement (description of the research context and the state of research of the specific scientific debate/artistic engagement)
 - research question arising from the problem statement
 - aim(s)/hypothes(i/e)s
 - methodology
 - time schedule
 - resources required
 - estimated costs
- 4) Letter of recommendation (max. one A4-page) from a person with relevant professional expertise (e.g. project supervisor, main subject teacher etc.)

All application papers (in German or English, PDF format) must be sent **via e-mail** to iggs@moz.ac.at. Applications will be **accepted on a rolling basis throughout the year**. Support available on a first-come-first-serve basis. In the case of a grant, applicants will be informed in written form.
